#### 3. Build Strategic Messaging to Navigate Resistance

- Prepare leaders to communicate prerogative-based decisions in a way that fosters unity, not conflict.
- o Develop audience-aware messaging for union leaders, command staff, and frontline personnel to communicate with them effectively.
- Use visual models, quick-reference cards, and branded frameworks to reinforce legitimacy and reduce friction.
